Remind: Safe adults are helpers, and unsafe situations are never your fault

Scenarios:

Teacher helps you tie shoes → Safe

Stranger asks you to go with them → Not safe

Friend shares a book → Safe

Someone takes your backpack and says keep it secret → Not safe

Lawson helps a friend → Safe

Someone yells and blames you for being scared → Not safe
